

## THE ARRANGEMENT OF THE YEAR

5772 from the creation of the world. Symbol is ה"כ"ז: Rosh HaShanah falls out on Thursday (the fifth day of the week; Cheshvan is 29 days and Kislev is 30 days (כסדרן); Pesach falls out on Shabbos (the seventh day of the week). The year is a regular year consisting of 354 days and containing 51 Shabosos. It is the 15th year of the 304th minor (19 year) Lunar cycle and the 4th year of the 207th major (28 year) Solar cycle. It is the 4th year of the Shemitah cycle (seven years) according to the computation of the Gaonim and as is accepted as the custom in the Land of Israel.

The beginning of each of the four periods that mark the different seasonal skies are as follows:

Tekufas Tishrei: 10 Tishrei, Oct. 7 at 9:00 P.M.

Tekufas Teves: 12 Teves, Jan. 7, at 4:30 A.M.

Tekufas Nisan: 15 Nisan, Apr. 7 at 12:00 noon.

Tekufas Tamuz: 17 Tamuz, July 7, at 7:30 P.M.
