5783 from the creation of the world. Symbol is בּש"ח: Rosh HaShanah falls out on Monday (the second day of the week; Cheshvan and Kislev are both 30 days (the fifth day of the week). The year is a regular year consisting of 355 days and containing 50 Shabosos. It is the 7th year of the 305th minor (19 year) Lunar cycle and the 15th year of the 207th major (28 year) Solar cycle. It is the first year of the Shemitah cycle (seven years) according to the computation of the Gaonim and as is accepted as the custom in the Land of Israel.

The beginning of each of the four periods that mark the different seasonal skies are as follows:

Tekufas Tishrei: 12 *Tishrei,* Oct. 7 at 3:00 P.M.

Tekufas Teves: 13 Teves, Jan. 6, at 10:30 P.M.

Tekufas Nisan: 17 Nissan, Apr. 8 at 6:00 A.M.

Tekufas Tamuz: 19 Tamuz, July 8, at 1:30 P.M.
